### **DAY 1**

### **DAY 1**

We will depart this morning to discover a time when gasoline was not used to fuel our lives. We will make a short coffee stop on the way to the “Anthracite Capital of the World” Scranton, PA. Our first stop will be at the Electric City Trolley Station and Museum. Here we will be discovering the history of electric traction systems at the restoration shop, through interactive exhibits and a vintage trolley ride. Next, we go a couple of blocks away to the Radisson Lackawanna Station Hotel where we will enjoy a scrumptious lunch buffet. Built in 1908 and widely considered one of the most beautiful railroad terminals in the East, this breathtaking neo-classical structure is listed on the U.S. National Register of Historic Places. After lunch, we will travel to the Lackawanna County Coal Mine for a guided tour. Everyone is encouraged to bring a jacket as the mines will be at a temperature of about 50 degrees and wear comfortable shoes. Recreating the experience of the American coal miner like no other, this amazing interactive experience lets visitors explore 300 feet below the earth in an 1860 coal mine. We will return to the hotel to freshen up before visiting the Mohegan Sun at Pocono Downs to enjoy nearly 2,500 slots and virtual table games and a buffet dinner.
